

TOWN OF ELLINGTON NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Ellington will hold a public hearing on Monday, August 27, 2007, at 6:00 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to discuss a proposed Federal FY 2007 Small Cities CDBG grant application to the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development, to report on the progress of current and recent Small Cities grants and to discuss Ellington's community development and housing needs. Under the proposed FY07 grant, the following activity is currently being considered: funding to continue and to expand the town's housing rehabilitation program. The expansion under consideration is to include the towns of Somers and/or Suffield in a regional, multi-jurisdictional program, with Ellington as the lead community. The grant application may include this activity, as well as additional ones.

The public hearing will also provide the public with an update on the progress of the Town's current and recent past grants, as well as discuss its housing and community development needs.

The hearing will be held in the Selectmen's Meeting Room (2nd Floor) of Town Hall. Any person or organization so wishing will be afforded an opportunity to be heard. Suggestions for other potential activities for the grant application may be made at the hearing, or before the hearing by contacting the Town's Community Development Office in Town Hall. The Town encourages a broad spectrum of participation by residents and other interested parties in order to better understand and serve the needs of the community. The hearing location is accessible to persons with physical disabilities.
