

**Legal Notice
Town of Ellington
Adjourned Town Meeting
Notice of Referendum
May 30, 2007**

Any person who is an elector of the Town, and any United States citizen of the age of Eighteen years or more who, jointly or severally, is liable to the Town for taxes on an Assessment of not less than one thousand dollars on the last completed grand list of the Town are hereby warned to meet at the **ELLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL** polling place in said Town of Ellington on **Wednesday May 30, 2007** to cast their ballot for a vote on the following question, pursuant to the Connecticut General Statute 7-7 and the Adjourned Town Meeting of May 23, 2007:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF ELLINGTON APPROPRIATE, UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF, AND AS ALLOCATED BY THE BOARD OF FINANCE, THE TOTAL SUM FOR ALL EXPENDITURES, A/K/A BUDGET GRAND TOTAL, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008 THE SUM OF \$41,420,289? ”

Voters approving said question will vote **“YES”**
and those opposing said question will vote **“NO”**.

Registered voters may make application for Absentee Ballots, in person only, in the Town Clerk's Office at 55 Main Street.
Absentee Ballots will be counted at Ellington High School.

The polls will be opened at six o'clock (6:00 a.m.) in the morning
and will remain open until eight o'clock (8:00 p.m.) in the evening.

Notice is hereby given that the location of the polling place is as follows:

Ellington High School Gymnasium, 37 Maple Street, Ellington, Connecticut.
