NOTICE OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING TOWN OF ELLINGTON November 5, 2007


A Special Town Meeting of the electors and citizens qualified to vote in Town Meetings of the Town of Ellington, Connecticut, will be held at the Ellington Town Hall, 55 Main Street, Ellington, Connecticut, on Monday, November 5, 2007, at 7:15 p.m. prevailing time to discuss and vote upon the following:

To consider 2006-2007 year-end transfers and additional appropriations as follows:

- a) to appropriate \$224,933 **from** FY 2006-07 Unreserved General Fund Balance to the following accounts: Police - \$57,645; Police Special Duty - \$44,886; Town Road Aid-Materials - \$37,755; Hall Memorial Library - \$30,106 and Town Hall - \$54,541, as recommended by the Finance Officer and approved by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance.
- b) to appropriate \$204,211 **from** FY 2006-07 Unreserved-General Fund Balance to the FY 2006-07 Capital Non-recurring Fund following accounts: Local Capital Improvement Program - \$130 (*matching state grant*); Road Overlay - \$80,253; Brookside Park Fencing - \$1,989 and BOE-Windermere School Addition - \$121,839, as recommended by the Finance Officer and approved by Boards of Selectmen and Finance.
- c) to increase prepaid grants and funds fully reimbursable for fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2006 and ending on June 30, 2007 and to appropriate the same to the Board of Education in a sum not to exceed \$107,554. New allocation total is \$720,454 (\$612,900 approved at town meeting May 9, 2006 plus \$107,554), as recommended by the Finance Officer and approved by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance.
