Any person who is an elector of the Town, and citizens qualified to vote in town meetings who are not electors

are hereby warned to meet at the **ELLINGTON HIGH SCHOOL** polling place in said Town of Ellington on **Wednesday October 11, 2006** to cast their ballot for a vote on the following question, pursuant to the Connecticut General Statute 7-7 and the Adjourned Town Meeting of October 3, 2006:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF ELLINGTON APPROPRIATE \$2,035,000 FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PINNEY STREET FIRE STATION PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS AND NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

Voters approving said question will vote **“YES”** and those opposing said question will vote **“NO”**.

Absentee ballots will be available from the Town Clerk's Office. Absentee Ballots will be counted at Ellington High School, 37 Maple Street, Ellington, Connecticut.

The polls will be opened at six o'clock (6:00a.m.) in the morning and will remain open until eight o'clock (8:00p.m.) in the evening.
